**Project title:** Characterization of mechanisms that allow hepatitis viruses to repro-

gram the host cell response to inflammatory cytokines

**Research focus:** My project is concerned with analysing how a Hepatitis C infection can

lead to an altered signalling pathway in the immune response resulting in inflammation. In this context, the dysregulation of the NF $\kappa$ B signalling pathway and AP1 activation and its consequences for the host cells' response to cytokines such as IL-1 $\beta$  is investigated. A focus lays thereby on the influence of endogenous repressors and epigenetic histone

modifications.
